***Last Meeting: June 4 - Marc Byers explained operations for the Downtown Annual Color program***

Marc Byers told how his city department prepares and hangs the beautiful basket and planters throughout downtown. The pictures to the right show the baskets and the sidewalk planters created and maintained by Marc's department. The city now grows their own plants in the greenhouse (near Lowe mill) on the next page. The hanging baskets are grown in the green pots shown on the next page as well – note the small plants growing from each hole in the side of the pot. The baskets grow from February until April when they are hung on the poles around tax day.

Maintenance crews water each plant four times each day using a custom trailer of water. The team has experience with many plants so they grow the plants purchased from companies in Guatemala and Ethiopia that grow them from cuttings. They use Osmocote slow release fertilizer on the baskets throughout the blooming cycle.
